

Primary Care Networks

Purpose

1. This report introduces Dr Mark Sanderson, Medical Director, Cambridgeshire and Peterborough CCG, who will inform the Board and invite discussion about the local development of primary care networks.

Key issues

2. As part of the NHS Long Term Plan¹ each area is required to establish primary care networks. These networks require GPs to come together in groups typically covering 30-50,000 people. The CCG is required to approve the networks in May.
3. Dr Sanderson will explain how these networks are developing in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough and invite discussion regarding the local development of network, potential benefits and how local people can be involved.
